EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The upcoming 2026 provincial and national ICT tender cycles signal a definitive shift in SITA's evaluation criteria. The traditional "perimeter security" model is obsolete.

National Treasury now mandates a "Zero-Trust Architecture" (ZTA) aligned with ISO 27001 standards for all critical infrastructure bids.

Firms that fail to demonstrate a mature ZTA framework in their technical methodology will face immediate disqualification on functionality scoring, regardless of price.

2. Least-Privilege Access:

Methodologies must prove that access is restricted to the bare minimum required for function. "Admin access by default" is now a killer clause.

3. Sovereign Data Residency:

Cloud proposals must guarantee data persistence within South African borders, compliant with POPIA and SITA data sovereignty requirements.
